

WODDLAND PARK RULES

Marsh Landing Management and staff will enforce the rules set forth herein. Residents shall assume any and all responsibilities for themselves and their guests regarding behavior and property damage. Any resident or guest who violates the rules and regulations may be barred from using the park. Residents and their guests are to use the facilities at their own risk and must comply with all rules and regulations. Any behavior deemed unsuitable or inappropriate by other residents and their guests may result, at the option of the association board, in permanent suspension from the park. Report any irregularities to the Beach Boulevard gate at 223-1770 or to Marsh Landing Management at 273-3033.

1. Alcohol/Drugs/Gambling/Profanity

Persons under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs as well as gambling and use of profane language are not allowed on the premises. Violation of these rules or continual violations may result, at the option of the association board, in permanent suspension from the park.

2. Trash

Residents and guests are asked to use the facilities with the utmost of care. All residents and guests are responsible for picking up their own trash and depositing it in the nearest trash receptacle. Bag the trash and place in the trash holding area to the right of the facilities building. For safety purposes, absolutely no glass containers are allowed in the park.

3. Children

Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children at all times. Children, 10 years old and under, must be accompanied by an adult or supervisor at all times. No one under 18 years of age is allowed to cook on the barbecue facilities.

4. Fields/Courts

Ball fields and courts will be assigned on a first come/first serve basis if not previously reserved. If others are waiting, please be considerate and limit your time of play. No wheels (i.e. roller blades, skateboards, scooters or bicycles) are allowed on the courts. Proper shoes must be worn at all times. The lights on the basketball courts must be turned off at 10:00 p.m.

5. Miscellaneous

Smoking is prohibited in the park. Violations of the smoking rules may result, at the option of the association board, in suspension from the park. Bicycles and mopeds must be parked and locked in the designated areas and are not allowed inside the park. Motor vehicles and golf carts must be parked in designated areas or they will be towed. For safety purposes, shoes must be worn at all times. For reasons of safety and sanitation no pets are permitted anywhere at the park. Absolutely no fireworks of any kind are permitted in or around the park. No loitering is permitted at the park. All posted signs must be obeyed.
